



What is the United Kingdom?

The United Kingdom (UK) is the name of a country that is made up of four nations: England, Northern Ireland, Scotland, and Wales. The UK does not include Republic of Ireland, Isle of Man, and the Channel Islands (Jersey and Guernsey). These places are independent of the UK and have their own government


Figure 1 - The British Isles compared to the UK.


What is immigration?

We use the word **immigration** to mean someone who moves into a country or place (and **emigration** if someone moves out).



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Topography is the word given to the pattern of the natural features on Earth's surface, such as flat land, or areas of hills, mountains, and valleys. It also includes where rivers are located. Geographers use a specific type of map that indicates what areas of land are high up, hilly, steep, low down or flat. This is called a **topographic** map, (Figure 3). The map key shows the height of the land in metres.
